

Setting Up a Travel Plan




After logging into your HRCU Mobile App, you should see a Snapshot of your account, as shown here. To set up a *Travel Plan*, click on the *More* button at the bottom right.






Click on Card Management.







This is displaying which card you are going to be making the *Travel Plan* for. If you would like to set one up for another card of yours, simply swipe the card to the left and your next card will appear. Once you have the card you would like, scroll down until you see *Manage Travel Plans*.






Select Manage Travel Plans.






Since we want to set up a *Travel Plan*, we should click on *Add Travel Plan*.

Note: You can add up to 2 Travel Plans per card and each Travel Plan can be set to a maximum of 15 days. After this, it will be part of your normal spending pattern.



When setting up a *Manage Travel Plan*, you will be required to do Two Factor Authentication and verify your identity. You can elect to receive an email confirmation or a text message.



When setting up a *Travel Plan*, you will be required to do Two Factor Authentication and verify your identity. After receiving the *Security Token*, key it in here and click *Next*.
